Landscape Watering and Filling or Re-filling of Pools Schedule:

Prior to 8:00 am and after 8:00 pm on your designated watering days

**Addresses ending in an EVEN number – SUNDAYS and THURSDAYS
Addresses ending in an ODD number – SATURDAYS and WEDNESDAYS**

*Landscape watering may take place at any time if by means of a hand-held hose, faucet
filled bucket or watering can of 5 gallons or less, or drip irrigation system.*

**Vehicle Washing may take place prior to 10:00 am and after 8:00 pm on your
designated watering days and MUST be done with a faucet-filled bucket of five (5)
gallons or less, or with a hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle.**

*Vehicle washing will be permitted at any time on the immediate premises of a
commercial car wash or service station.*

**The following uses of water are defined as non-essential and are
PROHIBITED:**

- 1. Operation of any ornamental fountain or pond unless necessary to support aquatic life, or is equipped with a re-circulation system.**
- 2. Use of water to wash down sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, buildings, structures, or other hard-surfaced areas.**
- 3. Use of water for dust control.**
- 4. Flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street.**
- 5. Failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s).**
